

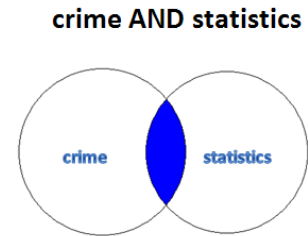


Have you ever searched for information using either a library database or an Internet search engine (like Google) and retrieved either too many, not enough, or irrelevant results? Make your searches more specific using the **AND**, **OR**, and **NOT** connectors. **AND** will narrow your search; **OR** will broaden your search; and **NOT** will eliminate a term or concept from your search.

AND

narrows the search

Articles must contain **BOTH** terms.



OR

broadens the search

Articles can contain **EITHER** term, not necessarily **BOTH**.



NOT

eliminates a term or concept from the search

All articles contain the first term. All articles with the second term are dropped even if they have the first term.
